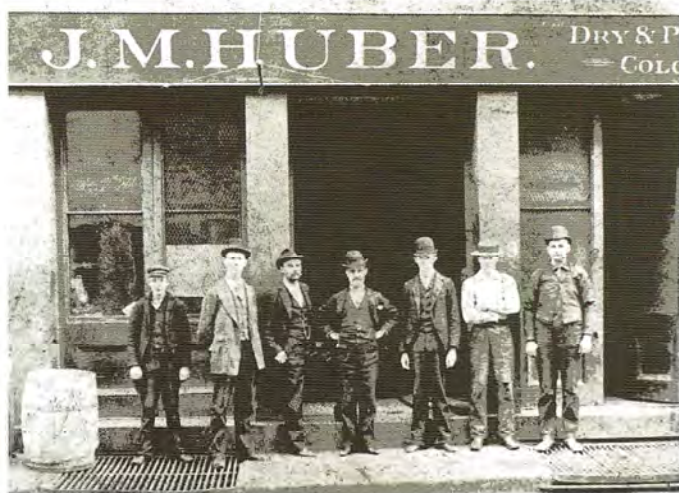

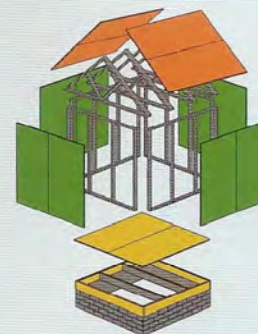

CONCERN FOR THE ENVIRONMENT GREEN BUILDING PROGRAMS

At Huber Engineered Woods, we're committed to environmental responsibility. Our environmental initiatives contribute to sustainability, good indoor air quality and increased energy efficiency.

- All Huber mills are certified by the Sustainable Forestry Initiative (SFI) to promote sustainable forestry practices through procurement programs, research initiatives, and logger and landowner outreach.



- Every year we provide over 2.5 million seedlings to private landowners as part of our SFI outreach efforts to help them practice sustainable forestry.
- Each of our plants employs state-of-the-art environmental control equipment and maintains strict control standards to ensure that the manufacturing of Huber products has a minimal impact on the environment.
- Beyond utilizing wood, which is one of nature's most renewable resources, our manufacturing process uses small, fast-growing trees to lessen the environmental impact. With our products, no part of the log goes to waste. Our wood waste is used to help fuel our manufacturing facilities.
- As energy efficiency and indoor air quality become more important to homeowners and builders alike, Huber is focused on products that help make homes more energy efficient and promote good indoor air quality.
